VACANCIES IN AIR FORCE SCHOOL BEGUMPET

1. Air Force School Begumpet is inviting applications for preparing annual selection panel for various posts for **AY 2025-26** as per details given below:

2. **PRINCIPAL:**

(a) **Mandatory Qualifications.**

(i) **Academic Qualification.** Masters Degree, with a minimum aggregate of 50 percent, from any University recognised by the Govt of India/UGC/AICTE. The Masters Degree should be in any one of the subjects taught in the Secondary classes of that Air Force School. Those holding a Masters Degree in any other subject will not be eligible for the post.

(ii) **Professional Qualification.** A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/ National Council of Teachers Education.

(iii) **Experience.** Teaching experience of at least two years as a TGT or experience of at least two years as Principal of a Secondary or a Primary Air Force School.

(iv) **Age.**

(aa) Should be in the age group of 35 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled. There will be no upper age limit in the case of serving staff of Air Force Schools but they should have at least two years of residual service as on 01 July of the academic year in which they are being considered for the post.

(ab) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

(ac) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

(ad) Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT or at least three years continuous service as a TGT in any Air Force School but presently not working in a Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.

(v) **Language:** Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English.

(b) **Desirable Qualifications (Due weightage to be given during selection).**

- (i) Knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.
- (ii) Conversant with POCSO Act, CBSE rules, NCERT etc.
- (iii) Attended educational workshops.
- (iv) Ability to read/write/communicate in Hindi.
- (v) CTET/STET qualified candidates will be given additional weightage during selection.

3. **TRAINED GRADUATE TEACHERS (TGTs)**

(a) **Mandatory Qualifications.** A Masters or a Bachelor's Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE with a minimum marks of 50 percent in the subject and 50 percent in the aggregate, including electives and languages, in the combination of subjects as under :-

- (i) TGT (Sanskrit): Sanskrit as an elective subject at Degree level
- (ii) TGT (Hindi): Hindi as an elective subject at Degree level
- (iii) TGT (English): English as an elective subject at Degree level
- (iv) TGT (Social Studies): Any two out of History, Geography, Economics or Political Science, of which one must be either History or Geography.
- (v) TGT (Maths): Maths with any two out of Physics, Chemistry, Electronics, Computer Science or Statistics
- (vi) TGT (Science): Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Botany and Zoology (Any three subjects should have been studied).
- (vii) Health Wellness Teacher: Diploma in Counselling from a Teacher recognized University or BA/BSc Psychology with Educational Psychology/Counseling Psychology from a recognised University or MA/MSc in Counseling Psychology or MA/MSc Psychology with Counseling Psychology as specialisation or MA/ MSc in Applied Psychology with Counseling Psychology from a recognised University.
- (viii) TGT (Music):
 - (aa) Degree in Music from a Govt recognised University.
 - OR
 - (ab) Higher Secondary with any of the following, viz., Sangeet Visharad of Gandharva Mahavidyalaya Mumbai.
 - OR

(ac) Bhatkhande Sangeet Vidyapeeth, Lucknow.

OR

(ad) Indira Kala Sangeet Vishwavidyalaya, Khairagarh (Chhattisgarh).

OR

(ae) Sangeet Prabhakar Examination of Prayag Sangeet Samiti, Allahabad.

OR

(af) Equivalent qualification from other Govt recognised institutions.

OR

(ag) Degree/Diploma awarded by Pracheen Kala Kendra, Chandigarh in the following categories, viz., Sangeet Bhasker with graduation in any disipline, Sangeet/ Nritya Bhushan with graduation in any disipline, Sangeet Bhushan with Sr Sec/ Sec/ Pt I of three-year degree course and Sangeet/ Nritya Visharad with Sr Sec/ Sec/ Pt I of three-year degree course.

(ix) TGT (Games): Degree in Physical Education or its equivalent from any Govt recognized institution.

(x) TGT (Computer): PGDCA/ MCA/ BE from any Govt recognized institution.

(xi) TGT (Drawing):

(aa) Diploma in Drawing and Painting/Sculpture/Graphic Art from any Govt recognized institution.

OR

(ab) Four years' Diploma in Fine Arts and Crafts from Viswa Bharati, Shanti Niketan.

OR

(ac) Diploma in Fine Arts from Govt. School of Arts and Crafts, Patna.

OR

(ad) M.A. in Drawing and Painting from Agra University, Agra.

OR

(ae) Degree/ Diploma in Fine Arts from Regional Colleges of Education

(b) A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/ university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/National Council of Teachers Education. However, **B.Ed. degree is not mandatory for the post of TGT (Computers), TGT (Music), TGT (Games), TGT (Drawing) and Health Wellness Teacher.**

(c) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

- (d) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.
- (e) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.
- (f) Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT or three years as a PRT/NTT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.
- (g) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English (except TGT Hindi, Sanskrit, Games and Drawing).
- (h) **Desirable Qualifications** (Due weightage to be given during selection).
- (i) Knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.
- (ii) Ability to read/write/communicate in Hindi.
- (iii) CTET/STET qualified candidates will be given additional weightage during selection.

4. **PRIMARY TEACHERS (PRTs)**

(a) **Mandatory Qualifications.**

- (i) ~~Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 2-year Diploma in Elementary Education from a recognized board.~~
- OR
- (ii) Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 4-year Bachelor in Elementary Education (B EDI Ed).
- OR
- (iii) Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 2-year Diploma in Education (Special Education).
- OR
- (iv) Graduation with at least 50% marks and Bachelor of Education (B Ed) from any NCTE recognized along with six-month Bridge Course in Elementary Education recognized by the NCTE.
- (v) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

(vi) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

(vii) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

(viii) Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT or three years as a PRT/NTT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.

(xi) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English.

(b) **Desirable Qualifications** (Due weightage to be given during selection).

(i) Knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.

(ii) Ability to read/write/communicate in Hindi.

(iii) CTET/STET qualified candidates will be given additional weightage during selection.

5. **NURSERY TRAINED TEACHER (NTT)**

(a) **Mandatory Qualifications.**

(i) Senior Secondary with Nursery Teachers Training diploma or diploma in Nursery/Montessori/Pre-Primary Teachers Training or Diploma in Elementary Education from a Govt recognised institution. While candidates with higher qualifications may apply, preference is to be given to candidates with diploma in Nursery/Montessori Training.

(ii) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

(iii) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

(iv) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition

regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

(v) Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT/PRT/ or three years as NTT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.

(vi) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English.

(b) **Desirable Qualifications** (Due weightage to be given during selection).

(i) Basic knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.

(ii) Should be able to read/write/communicate in Hindi.

(iii) Experience in art, craft, cartoon, caricature, puppet making, music, and dance.

6. **LIBRARIAN.**

(a) University degree in Library Science or graduate with one year diploma in Library Science from a Govt recognised institution.

(b) Should be in the age group of 25 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

(c) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

(d) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

(e) Candidates with at least two years continuous service in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School, subject to a maximum of two years. Serving staff of the School who apply for the post will also be eligible for the same.

(f) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English and Hindi.

(g) Basic knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.

7. **OFFICE SUPERINTENDENT**

- (a) Graduate with at least five years' experience in office work.
- (b) Should be in the age group of 25 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.
- (c) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.
- (d) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.
- (e) Candidates with at least two years continuous service in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School, subject to a maximum of two years. Serving staff of the School who apply for the post will also be eligible for the same.
- (f) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English.
- (g) Basic knowledge of computer typing and applications, especially MS Office.

8. **LAB ATTENDANT.**

- (a) 10+2 with Science.
- (b) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.
- (c) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.
- (d) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.
- (e) Candidates with at least two years continuous service in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School, subject to a

maximum of two years. Serving staff of the School who apply for the post will also be eligible for the same.

(f) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English or Hindi.

9. **ACCOUNTS ASSISTANT**

(a) B Com from a Govt recognised University with knowledge of accounts and book-keeping.

(b) Typing speed of at least 40 wpm in English.

(c) Basic knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.

(d) Should be in the age group of 25 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

(e) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

(f) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

(g) Candidates with at least two years continuous service in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School, subject to a maximum of two years. Serving staff of the School who apply for the post will also be eligible for the same.

(h) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English or Hindi.

10. **CLERK.**

(a) Graduate from a Govt recognised University.

(b) Typing speed of at least 40 wpm in English.

(c) Should be in the age group of 25 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

(d) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

(e) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

(f) Candidates with at least two years continuous service in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School, subject to a maximum of two years. Serving staff of the School who apply for the post will also be so eligible.

(g) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English and Hindi.

(h) Basic knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office & MS Excel.

11. **HELPER**

(a) No educational qualifications are laid down. However, candidates should be selected keeping in view suitability for trade duties.

(b) Should be in the age group of 21 to 40 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

(c) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

(d) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

(e) Candidates with at least two years continuous service in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School, subject to a maximum of two years.

12. **GARDENER/ SAFAIWALA/WATCHMAN (ON CONTRACTUAL):**

(a) No educational qualifications are laid down. However, candidates should be selected keeping in view suitability for watchman duties.

(b) Should be in the age group of 21 to 40 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

13. **Part Time Instructors (Basketball coach, Football coach, Volleyball coach, Cricket coach, Dance & Karate/Taekwondo):**

(a) Experience in the relevant field in any institute/ Certificate Course.

14. Candidates to note that as and when any staff leaving in between the academic session 2025-26, the vacancies will be filled from the empanelled candidates as per their merit. **Selection panel is valid for Academic Year 2025-26 only.**

15.
